8.	<b>Description of the training post</b>	DCTs in <b>Restorative Dentistry</b> attend consultant led new patient clinics and multidisciplinary clinics. They undertake a wide range of restorative treatments including periodontal treatment, endodontic, fixed and removable prosthodontics, conservative dentistry, and prevention  This posts will offer a significant exposure to oral surgery. The successful candidates will participate in oral surgery clinics and operating lists both under local and general anaesthetic. The trainees have also access to their own minor oral surgery lists with indirect supervision. The posts also involved exposure to some aspects of maxillofacial surgery involving facial deformity / orthognathic surgery, facial skin surgery, salivary gland pathology and surgery, temporo-mandibuar joints and some aspects of head and neck intraoral cancer.

10.	<b>Pattern of working, including any on-call commitment</b>	Post include new patient clinics and treatment sessions and some multidisciplinary clinics. On call: Not resident, 1:5 weekdays and 1:5 weekends Timetables varies slightly between DCTs, however all timetable will have access to training list in oral surgery (local and general anaesthetic), maxillofacial surgery and general clinics. Each DCT will also have her/his own (although supervised) dento-alveolar surgery list under

11.	<b>Educational programme summary and library facilities</b>	<p>There is a postgraduate library at Taunton which holds a good number of relevant journals. Basic textbooks are also available and some further textbooks are available within the Department. Regular meetings are held in the Postgraduate Centre on Wednesdays/Fridays on all topics of medical interest and junior staff are encouraged to attend.</p> <p>All DCTs also gain experience in managing patients with complex medical histories. DCTs participate in departmental meetings, audit and journal clubs. In addition they can attend seminars, hands on practical courses and are encouraged to attend and present at regional and national Specialist Society meetings.</p>
