## Training Details

### **UH Bristol, Bristol Dental Hospital (BDH)**

The Senior Speciality Trainee (ST4-ST5) has six sessions within the Child Dental Health department and will gain experience relevant to an NHS Consultant in a large teaching institution. This includes multidisciplinary clinics covering joint clinics with restorative, paediatric and surgical colleagues. The trainee has responsibility for planning joint cases for the multidisciplinary clinics, including the joint facial clinics at the Dental Hospital.

Relevant experience in supervising undergraduate dental students and providing teaching material for seminars and lectures is also gained. The trainee is also responsible for contributing to the DDS Programme journal club for the more junior trainees in orthodontics. The regional cleft unit is located within the Dental Hospital and the trainee will attend multidisciplinary cleft clinics.

### **Musgrove Park Hospital, Taunton & Somerset NHS Trust**

The Senior Speciality Trainee (ST4-ST5) attends the Orthodontic Department four sessions per week, under the supervision of the orthodontic consultants, in order to gain experience of direct relevance to a regional district general hospital orthodontic consultant post. The Senior Speciality Trainee will attend Joint Orthognathic Clinics as well as Joint Oral Surgery clinics and Joint Restorative Clinics in Taunton and will be expected to carry out much of the orthognathic planning.

## Duties and Responsibilities of postholder

### a) Clinical

The Trainee will have a personal caseload of multidisciplinary and other complex malocclusions and will take a leading part in new patient/review clinics involving a variety of dental and medical specialties.

Trainees are expected to undertake a reflective log of cleft related experience including clinics and theatre, based on previous experience and discussions with the Lead Orthodontist for the cleft service. Orthodontic treatment sessions with children and adults with a cleft can be arranged as required with the cleft team.

### b) Teaching

Undergraduate Dental Students, Bristol Dental Hospital: The supervised teaching and clinical training of an undergraduate group of students is an important part of the post. There are opportunities to teach on postgraduate training days for a range of dentists and dental care professionals.

Nurses and Other PCD Staff. On occasions a trainee may be asked to give lectures to these staff.

Orthodontic StRs. The holders of these posts have a significant role in the running of the regular journal clubs and mock examinations involving more junior StRs.

### c) Study/Research

Study and examination leave allowance are as stated in the Terms and Conditions of Service.

Facilities for research are available for approved projects.

### d) Administrative

The routine administrative content of this post is allowed for in the timetable.

The holder of this post is entitled to attend meetings of the Division of Junior Medical Staff, and is represented by two NHS Senior Specialist Registrars at meetings of the Medical Advisory Group for the Dental Hospital.

e) Audit

Orthodontics is a small speciality within the South West Region and so audit takes place principally at a Regional and sub-regional level. Registrars attend all these meetings and take a full part. The departments participate in all national specialty audits.

### **Description of main training site**

#### **University of Bristol Dental Hospital, University Bristol Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust (BDH)**

The University of Bristol Dental Hospital lies within the University Hospitals Bristol NHS Foundation Trust (UHB) and is situated in the city centre, close to the Medical School and University. The Trust consists of several hospitals, including Bristol Royal Infirmary, Bristol General Hospital, St Michael's Hospital, Bristol Eye Hospital, Bristol Royal Hospital for Children, Bristol Haematology & Oncology Centre (BHOC) as well as the Dental Hospital. UHB provides a full range of NHS services in hospitals and the community and is a focus of excellence at a local level and nationally as a centre for NHS teaching and research.

The University of Bristol Dental Hospital and School is the major provider of dental specialist service in the South West Region, in addition to providing emergency service and undergraduate teaching. The Hospital and School have an excellent national and international reputation for patient care, scholarship and research. Many of the clinical areas have been or are being refurbished. The Chapter House extension enhances the facilities for teaching and research and includes a staff restaurant and lounge. The Dental Postgraduate Dean and staff are on site in the Chapter House, enabling close co-operation in the planning of postgraduate training. In 2012 a new community hospital opened in South Bristol and undergraduate students are exposed to a broad range of primary care clinical experiences through rotations in this facility.

The Dental Hospital and School clinical groups are as follows:

- Oral Medicine, Pathology and Microbiology
- Child Dental Health (including Orthodontics)
- Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery
- Restorative Dentistry

The Orthodontic Department has two main functions, firstly the teaching of Dental Undergraduate and Postgraduates on longitudinal courses and secondly, the treatment of child and adult orthodontic patients.

The Orthodontic trainee attends monthly cleft lip and palate clinics in the South West Cleft Unit. The Bristol Cleft Team is, with Swansea, a member of the South Wales and South West Clinical Network for cleft lip and palate care. The Bristol cleft team comprises primary surgeons, secondary surgeons, speech and language therapists, psychologists, feeding specialist nurses and support staff. The team organises and co-ordinates the delivery of an integrated cleft lip and palate service for the South West.

**Description of second training site**

**Musgrove Park Hospital, Taunton & Somerset (NHS) Trust**

Musgrove Park Hospital is a 722 bedded District General Hospital providing a full range of acute services.

The Orthodontic Department is a well-established department within the Trust, its principal functions being the treatment of complex cases, including cleft lip and palate patients, hypodontia cases, and those with craniofacial deformity, and the teaching of orthodontic trainees. It is closely linked to the Maxillofacial Department and is located in the Duchess Building on Level 1. It occupies excellent facilities which include a well-equipped three chair open plan clinic; a separate single chair surgery; reception and waiting areas; x-ray room with OPT/ lateral cephalogram/ 3D and intraoral machines; model box room; Junior Staff office (shared with Oral Surgery); staff room; Consultants office. The department uses the services of the Orthodontic/Maxillofacial Laboratory located within Musgrove Park Dental Centre, on the DGH site.

Musgrove Park Hospital has an active Academy with three full-time administrative staff. The Academy has been extended and improved in order to provide a new teaching facility for the medical students to rotate to the hospital as part of their training in Bristol. There is a well stocked library with a full-time librarian and the usual audio visual aids and complete research facilities. A full-time medical photographer is available to help in the preparation of material for lectures and publications.

### Other information

The ST4- ST5 trainees attend monthly cleft lip and palate clinics in the dedicated South West Cleft outpatient unit at Bristol Dental Hospital. The Bristol Cleft Team is, with Swansea, a member of the South Wales and South West Clinical Network for cleft lip and palate care.

The Bristol cleft team comprises primary surgeons, secondary surgeons, orthodontist, speech and language therapists, psychologists, feeding specialist nurses and support staff. The team organises and co-ordinates the delivery of an integrated cleft lip and palate service for the South West.

#### Other Facilities

##### a) Clubs

Junior Medical and Dental Staff have access to the University sports facilities as honorary members of the University. When applying for membership, identification must be produced as to the post he/she holds in the Trust.

##### b) Car/cycle parking

There is a car park at the back of the Dental Hospital, but this is restricted to priority groups. Dedicated cycle parking is available.

There is car parking at Taunton & Somerset. Permits need to be applied for from the operator, Q Parks.

##### c) Transport

The intercity and bus terminus is very near to BDH and other city bus routes pass within a couple of minutes walking distance. There are two Bristol railway stations and trains to London take approximately 1½ hours. The airport is about 9 miles distance. Travel between Bristol and Taunton takes approximately 1 hour by car or 30 mins by train. The journey from Taunton to London takes approximately two hours by rail.
